Rippon Lea Estate is a large nineteenth century mansion surrounded by 14 acres of Victorian pleasure gardens. It is listed on the National Heritage Register because it is one of the finest examples of an original suburban estate in the world.

The garden is complex and covers almost 14 acres, which includes a large lake, extensive shrubberies and flower gardens, an orchard of historically significant fruit varieties, a fernery and many other features of historical, landscape and architectural interest, all forming the setting for the polychrome brick mansion completed in 1868.

Please note: the tower at the lake is currently closed for repairs and maintenance

Guided Tours

The Mansion

Entry to the mansion is via guided tour only.

Join our wonderful volunteer guides for a tour and learn about Rippon Lea's history and the people who called this amazing place home.

Mansion tours run daily from 10.30am – 3pm* and are 45 minutes duration.

The Gardens

There are 14 acres of grounds to explore. Join one of our garden tours and learn all about the social history of the estate.

Garden tours run most days between 11am – 2pm* are 45 minutes duration.

Glen Eira Residents - Garden Entry

Residents of Glen Eira have free access to the gardens at Rippon Lea.

Guided tours of the mansion and gardens are an additional \$5 per person, per tour.

To obtain an entry card, residents must show acceptable forms of ID with proof of residency and complete an application form available in the Gatehouse on entry to the property.

Please note: It is a condition of entry that the Garden Entry card must be presented each visit. Without the card, general admission fees apply.
